Wood Green Traffic and Parking Review (Ringslade & Watson's roads traffic issues)

Dear Resident/Trader,

The council committed to consult on elements of a traffic and parking review in the central Wood Green area, on which we have made good progress.

One of the projects was traffic improvements in Watsons and Ringslade Roads. This included maintenance of footways, upgraded street lighting, as well as a width restriction preventing large vehicles from entering the roads. However, public consultation results did not support the improvement in Watsons Road and Ringslade Road without a road closure. This has not been possible due to traffic flows and physical limitations.

In response to public concerns regarding traffic volumes in those roads, we have been exploring the possibility of introducing a right turn into Station Road at its junction with the High Road. A lot of work has been undertaken to investigate options and the impact that they may have on traffic volumes in the wider area. This has involved working very closely with Transport for London.

The council now intends holding a public meeting on this issue on 16th July 2015, so as to update the wider community on the outcomes of those investigations and explore possible next steps.

However prior to that, the Cabinet Member for Environment, Cllr Stuart McNamara is keen to understand the views of all stakeholders in the vicinity, including those who may not otherwise attend the wider public meeting. He will be available with officers from the council on the afternoons of 8th and 9th of July between 14:00 and 18:30 for 30minute appointments for those interested in speaking to him on this matter, or wider traffic issues in the immediate area. A meeting time can then be arranged here at River Park House, opposite Wood Green station.

If you would like to meet please email us with the reference 'drop in booking' at frontline.consultation@haringey.gov.uk stating your name, phone number, any organisation that you may represent and also your preferred time/date. Someone will then be in touch to confirm a booking for you.

Please note that due to room size and for practical discussion to take place the maximum number of attendees for each session will be limited to three. If you represent a local group please select spokespersons to attend. We will also offer multiple bookings per organisation if this is not possible up to a reasonable level.
